Faculty Development Summary 2017-2018

Key Points


In the 2017-2018 academic year:

- 113 UCSF Educational Skills Workshops and Grand Rounds taught by 105 faculty developers
- 4.43 out of 5 mean overall session rating
- 1887 participants; 792 unique individuals attending multiple sessions
- 17 average participants per session
- 61% increase in workshops offered compared to 16-17 AY

Also:


- 31 TSP sessions offered
- 17 Teaching Scholars Program graduates
- 78 TOP Observers
- 4 UCB-UCSF Masters student, 8 UMCU-UCSF PhD students, and 28 HPE Learners mentored by CFE faculty

Location of Sessions by Site n=113




Participant Distribution by UCSF School

1=poor to 5 = excellent








Executive Summary 2017-2018

The Teach for UCSF Certificate program provides an accessible way for faculty and trainees to develop their educational skills. Participants develop expertise in specific teaching theme areas by completing a series of Educational Skills Workshops.


Key Points Teach for UCSF Certificates

- 6 Certificate Tracks Available
 - 1. General Teaching
 - 2. Clinical Teaching
 - 3. Simulation Teaching (and mini-certificate)
 - 4. Interprofessional Teaching
 - 5. Teaching Quality Improvement/Patient Safety
 - 6. Education Leadership
- 1174 total enrollments; 643 unique individuals (participants enroll in more than one certificate track)
- 500 new enrollments in 17-18; 244 unique individuals
- 53 certificates completed in 17-18; 144 certificates completed through 6/30/18.
